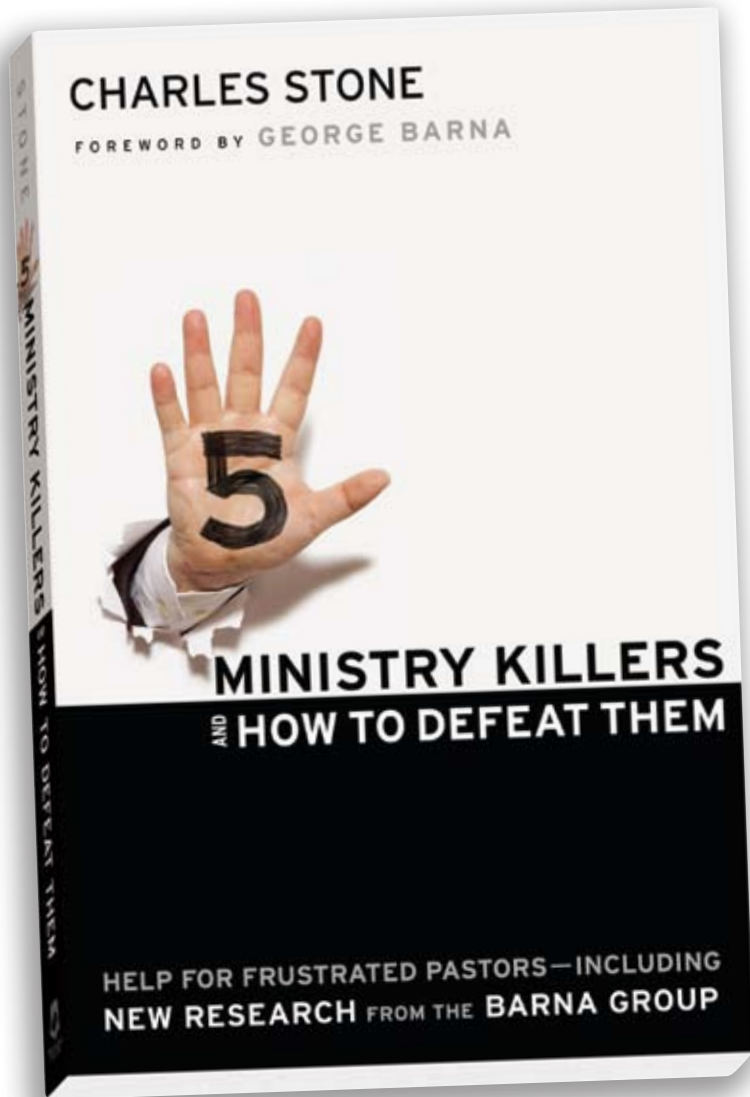


Latest Barna Group Research Offers Insight into Frustrations Pastors Face
